Agenda item 11.1.17 for the Regular Town Council meeting scheduled for April 24, 2018 (Request for speed reduction - Ballyduff Road and Lotus Road, report ENG2018-008)

I am a resident of Ballyduff Road, my home property is located on the east side of the hamlet of Lotus.

I wish to express my concern to council that the section of Ballyduff Road that my property fronts on has not been included in the proposed reduced speed limit area. The current report proposes a reduced speed limit beginning 810 meters west of the intersection of Ballyduff/Lotus Roads, but only 250 meters east of this intersection. I have safety concerns related to the proximity of my driveway to a "blind" corner and wish to speak about my experiences and observations.

What action are you hoping will result from your presentation/deputation? *

That report ENG2018-008 be sent back for revision, with the revised report to include a longer section (minimum of 800 meters) of Ballyduff Road east of Lotus Road in the reduced speed limit zone.
