A By-Law to Confirm the Proceedings of a Special Council Meeting of Council, Thursday, December 13, 2018

Recitals

- 1. The *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 c. 25 as amended, provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are exercised by its Council.
