With the producers of tires taking over the recycling program municipalities will no longer receive funding for recycling of tires. Municipalities have the option to continue to recycle tires with no revenue, or stop recycling tires and direct the public to other tire collectors. Staff plan to send out an RFP document to form an agreement with a tire hauler to ensure tire pick up through the new program as staff would like to continue to offer this service to the public.
