Due to increased rainfall there have been leachate outbreaks at Fenelon landfill, that are contained in the tip face. City Staff have used equipment to dig holes for the leachate to drain into.

7. Other New Business

7.1 Fenelon Redesign Update

An update, that at this time due to cost and loss in landfill capacity, the City will not be moving forward with WSP's redesign of the Fenelon landfill site.

Consideration will be given in the Waste Strategy to operating the site as a transfer station once the site has reached landfill capacity. The City will have to notify the MECP in 2021 or 2022 of a closure plan for the site and include a recommendation for post closure activity at this time.

7.2 Construction and Demolition Pilot Update

Kerri presented a Construction and Demolition pilot project update outlining the past and current programs in place.

Resolved that the Fenelon Landfill Public Review Committee supports continuing the pilot on construction and demolition recycling for another year.
