









### Ride Norfolk Public Transportation System





# Ride Norfolk Budget Totals



### \*Tax Levy Breakdown:

- Total Tax Levy impact \$101,700
- Impact Per Capita: \$1.58
- Impact Per Tax Bill: \$2.90

### **Average Per capita (2015):**

- Ontario: \$108.49
- Canada: \$120.11
- Pop Group (<50,000): \$31.91
- Pop Group (50,000 150,000): \$71.44
