# By-Law 2018-

### A By-law to Repeal By-law 2016-001, being A By-law to Appoint Additional Deputy Clerks for the City of Kawartha Lakes for Specific Purposes

#### Recitals

- 1. Council adopted By-law 2016-001 on January 12, 2016 to Appoint Additional Deputy Clerks for the City of Kawartha Lakes for Specific Purposes.
- 2. The City covers a broad geographic area and in order to provide effective service relating to the commissioning of documents for members of the public, we require staff at City Hall and at Service Centre locations to be appointed as Commissioners tor Taking Affidavits.
- 3. In past, Clerks Office and Service Centre staff acting as Commissioners for Taking Affidavits have had the authority to do so by virtue of their appointment as "Assistant Clerks" under By-law 2016-001.
- 4. Individual staff appointments have now been approved by the Ministry of the Attorney General and By-law 2016-001 is no longer required.
- 5. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 2016-001.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2018-\_\_\_.

### Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law,

"City", "City of Kawartha Lakes" or "Kawartha Lakes" means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"Council" or "City Council" means the municipal council for the City.

### Section 2.00: Repeals

2.01 **Repeal:** By-law 2016-001 is repealed.

## Section 3.00: Effective Date

3.01 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
