Subject: Noise By-Law Review

Background

The City passed a noise by-law in 2005 to regulate excessive noise and to prohibit specific activities during certain time frames. This by-law has been amended seven times with the latest amendment occurring in 2010. In recent discussions with staff they feel a review/update to the bylaw would be beneficial in order to address various complaints.

As part of on-going by-law review and since this by-law has not been reviewed in seven years, the recommendation in the memo is to review the by-law and recommend updates if required.

Recommendation To Council

RESOLVED THAT the memorandum from Councillor Strangway dated July 11, 2017 regarding Noise By-law Review, be received; and

THAT staff be directed to review By-law 2005-025, A By-law to Regulate Noise in the City of Kawartha Lakes and provide a report with the results of the review and any recommended changes by Q1, 2018.
