A By-law to Amend By-law 2016-206, The Consolidated Fees By-law in the City of Kawartha Lakes (Amendment No. 3)

Recitals

- 1. By-law 2016-206, a by-law to establish and require payment of fees for information, services, activities and use of City property in the City of Kawartha Lakes was adopted by Council on November 8, 2016.
- 2. On July 11, 2017, Council approved Resolution CR2017-XXX to adopt new entrance permits fees.
- 3. On July 11, 2017, Council approved Resolution CR2017-XXX to update Transit Fares
- 4. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law.
- 5. This by-law amends By-law 2016-206 to reflect those decisions.
