By-Law 2017-

A By-law to Amend By-law 2014-026, Being a By-law to Require the Owners of Yards within Kawartha Lakes to Clean and Clear them

Recitals

1. Council adopted the Clean and Clear By-law on January 14, 2014.
2. Council amended the Consolidated Fees By-law on November 22, 2016 to allow for additional administration fees to be charged to repeat offenders.
3. The wording in the current clean and clear by-law requires clarification as it relates to the fee to be charged for repeat offenders.
4. This By-law enacts the fee structure approved by Council.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017- .

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

- 1.01 **Definitions:** All definitions contained in By-law 2014-026 have the same meaning within this amendment.

Section 2.00: Amendment to Section 4.00 - Offences

- 2.01 That Section 4.06 be added to read as follows:

- 4.06 Where an owner has received a second, third and subsequent offence on the same property, an inspection administration charge shall apply as set out in Schedule A-9 to the Consolidated Fees By-law and if not paid shall be added to the tax roll of the property and shall be collected in a like manner as municipal taxes.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.

By-law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed, this 18th day of April, 2017.
