A By-law to Amend By-law 2015-124 – A By-law to Set a Line Fences Administration Fee for the City of Kawartha Lakes (Amendment No. 3)

Recitals

- 1. Council established a consolidated fees by-law in 2016 and an amendment was made to this by-law to remove the fees and place them in the Consolidated Fees By-law.
- 2. The remuneration fee for Fence Viewers was included in this amendment.
- 3. Remuneration is not considered a fee but a per diem payment for decision making responsibilities and therefore the rate should not have been removed from this By-law.
- 4. This By-law corrects that error.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017-___.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 <u>Definitions</u>: All definitions contained in By-law 2015-124 have the same meaning within this amendment.

Section 2.00: Amendment

2.01 <u>Amendment:</u> That Section 3.00 – Remuneration be deleted and replaced with the following:

Section 3.00 - Remuneration

- 3.01 <u>Remuneration:</u> Fence-Viewers shall be paid \$70.00 per site visit plus mileage at the prevailing City rate.
- 3.02 **Appeals:** Fence-Viewers that attend an appeal hearing shall be paid \$70.00 plus mileage at the prevailing City rate.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 <u>Administration of the By-law:</u> The City Clerk is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date**: This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
