A By-law to Amend By-law Number 2012-173 Being a By-law to Regulate Parking in the City of Kawartha Lakes (Amendment No. 12)

Recitals

- 1. Council adopted Resolution Number CR2017-287 approving amendments to By-law 2012-173.
- 2. This by-law enacts those approved amendment.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017-

Section 1.00: Amendments

1.01 **Section 2.08.2** – That Section 2.08.2 be added as follows:

2.08.2 **Three Hour Time Limit:** No person shall park a vehicle on any highway in the area on William Street South in Lindsay on the east side from the intersection of Russell Street south to a point approximately 89 metres.

1.02 **Schedule “A”:** That Schedule “A” be amended with the additions as follows:

Street	Geographic Area	Side	From	To	Time Restriction
Mary Street West	Lindsay	South	McQuarrie Road	West to a point 130 metres	8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Monday to Friday)
Mary Street West	Lindsay	North	Angeline Street	West to a point 73 metres	
Kent Street West	Lindsay	South	Angeline Street	East to Victoria Avenue	
Pottinger Street	Lindsay	North and South	Adelaide Street	West to the end of Pottinger Street	8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Monday to Friday)

Section 2.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 2.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 2.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
