By-Law 2017-

A By-law to Repeal Several By-laws Relating to Records Retention for the City of Kawartha Lakes and its Predecessor Municipalities

Recitals

1. Council approved a new records retention by-law to replace several previous retention by-laws by Resolution Number CR2017-XX.
2. This by-law repeals all previous by-laws relating to records retention adopted by the City and its predecessor municipalities.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017-.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

- 1.01 **Definitions:** In this by-law,

“City”, “City of Kawartha Lakes” or “Kawartha Lakes” means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"City Clerk" means the person appointed by Council to carry out the duties of the clerk described in section 228 of the Municipal Act, 2001;

“Council” or “City Council” means the municipal council for the City;

- 1.02 **Interpretation Rules:**

(a) The Schedules attached to this by-law form part of the by-law, and are enforceable as such.

(b) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

- 1.03 **Statutes:** References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.

- 1.04 **Severability:** If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.

Section 2.00: Repeal
