A By-law to Amend By-law Number 2016-009 Being a By-law to Provide Authority for the Execution of Certain Documents and Affix the Corporate Seal on Behalf of the City of Kawartha Lakes (Amendment No. 1)

Recitals

1. Council adopted a new Purchasing Policy on April 18, 2017 by By-law Number 2017-XXX.
2. As a result, a change to the Signing Authority By-law 2016-009 was approved by Resolution Number CR2017-XXX. This change clarifies that the signing authority for purchases are governed by the Purchasing Policy and other agreement signing is governed by the Signing Authority By-law.
3. This by-law effects that direction.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017-XX.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

- 1.01 **Definitions:** All definitions contained in By-law 2016-009 have the same meaning within this amendment.

Section 2.00: Amendment to Section 6 – Document Execution – Contracts and Agreements

- 2.01 **Section 6.01:** That Section 6.01 be deleted and replaced with the following:
- 6.01 **General Agreement:** This section applies to all contracts and agreements not specifically addressed in another section of this by-law or addressed in the Purchasing Policy. Where the agreement relates to a procurement, the requirements of the Purchasing Policy shall take precedence.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The City Clerk is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
