A By-law to Amend By-law Number 2016-009 Being a By-law to Provide Authority for the Execution of Certain Documents and Affix the Corporate Seal on Behalf of the City of Kawartha Lakes (Amendment No. 1)

#### Recitals

- Council adopted a new Purchasing Policy on April 18, 2017 by By-law Number 2017-XXX.
- 2. As a result, a change to the Signing Authority By-law 2016-009 was approved by Resolution Number CR2017-XXX. This change clarifies that the signing authority for purchases are governed by the Purchasing Policy and other agreement signing is governed by the Signing Authority By-law.
- 3. This by-law effects that direction.

#### **Section 1.00:** Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 <u>Definitions</u>: All definitions contained in By-law 2016-009 have the same meaning within this amendment.

# Section 2.00: Amendment to Section 6 – Document Execution – Contracts and Agreements

- 2.01 <u>Section 6.01</u>: That Section 6.01 be deleted and replaced with the following:
  - 6.01 <u>General Agreement:</u> This section applies to all contracts and agreements not specifically addressed in another section of this by-law or addressed in the Purchasing Policy. Where the agreement relates to a procurement, the requirements of the Purchasing Policy shall take precedence.

### Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 <u>Administration of the By-law:</u> The City Clerk is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 <u>Effective Date</u>: This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
