# A By-law to Appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Kawartha Lakes

#### **Recitals**

- 1. Section 15 of the Police Services Act R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15 authorizes municipal councils to appoint municipal law enforcement officers, who are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing their by-laws.
- 2. Council considers it advisable to appoint an individual to serve as a municipal law enforcement officer.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017-\_\_\_.

# Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law,

"City", "City of Kawartha Lakes" or "Kawartha Lakes" means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"Council" or "City Council" means the municipal council for the City;

**"Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement Officer"** means the person who holds that position and his or her delegate(s) or, in the event of organizational changes, another person designated by Council.

#### 1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The Schedules attached to this by-law form part of the by-law, and are enforceable as such.
- (b) The words "include" and "including" are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.
- 1.03 **<u>Statutes</u>**: References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.
- 1.04 **Severability**: If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.

### Section 2.00: Appointments

- 2.01 <u>Municipal Law Enforcement Officer</u>: Taylor Stewart is appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Kawartha Lakes in accordance with section 15 of the Police Services Act R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15.
- 2.02 **<u>Reporting Relationship</u>**: Taylor Stewart shall report to and be under the direction of the Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement.

## Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 <u>Administration of the By-law:</u> The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May, 2017.

By-law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed, this 2nd day of May, 2017.
