A By-law to Amend By-Law 2014-071 Being a By-Law to Establish and Require Payment to Recover Costs Expended on Behalf of the Lakeview Water Cooperative

Recitals

- 1. Council approved an amendment to By-law 2014-071 by Resolution Number 2015-1063 relating to responsibility of cost sharing at the Lakeview Water Cooperative.
- 2. This By-law enacts that direction.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017-.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2012-019 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

2.01 <u>Amendment:</u> Section 5.01 to By-law 2014-071 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 5.01: The owner of each separately assessed parcel of land identified in the Notice shall be responsible to pay for costs incurred by the City in order to comply with the Notice that includes:

- Required home water treatment system upgrades and installation costs
- 2. Their averaged share of the distribution network upgrades including new pump, intake and associated installation costs.
- 3. Legal costs associated with the execution of any required easement, lease. licence.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 <u>Administration of the By-law:</u> The Director of Public Works is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date**: This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
