Subject: Speeding on King Street, Lindsay

Background

Over the past six years there has been a dramatic increase in the number of complaints regarding the speed of traffic on King Street in Lindsay. As traffic pressures on Queen Street has diverted local vehicles, interested in avoiding delays, to King Street, it has become a speedway. As vacant land has been infilled and an apartment building has been built travelling and living on King Street has become increasingly more hazardous. The recent large developments off of Logie Street and the resulting increase of both vehicle and pedestrian traffic has further exasperated the problem.

Recommendation To Council

RESOLVED THAT the memo from Councillor Dunn regarding **Speeding on King Street, Lindsay,** be received;

THAT staff be directed to conduct the necessary investigation to place a four way stop at the intersection of King Street and Logie Street/St. David Street; and

THAT staff report back to Council no later than the last regular Council meeting of September, 2017 with recommendations.
