

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KAWARTHA LAKES

BY-LAW 2001 - 53

A BY-LAW TO FIX DAYS FOR SOLICITATION OF MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS BY PERSONS AND ORGANIZATIONS IN CHARITABLE OR PATRIOTIC WORK.

WHEREAS Section 236 (14) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M45, authorizes Councils of municipalities to pass a by-law to fix days when persons and organizations, in charitable or patriotic work, may solicit contributions of money from persons on highways, sidewalks and / or municipally owned properties within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes to fix days when persons and organizations in charitable or patriotic work, may occur on the highways, sidewalks and / or municipally owned properties within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 28(g) of the Interpretation Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. I.11, authorizes Councils to alter or revoke by-laws, regulations, rules or orders from time to time and to make others;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

1.1 In interpreting this by-law, the following definitions shall apply:

- a) "Charitable" shall mean a registered charity or not-for-profit organization;
- b) "City" shall mean the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes, City and Municipality shall have the same meaning.
- c) "Clerk" shall mean the person appointed by Council under the Municipal Act to perform the duties of that office for the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes;
- d) "Council" shall mean the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes;
- e) "Highway" shall mean the travelled roadway within the City, highway and street shall have the same meaning;
- f) "Sidewalks" shall mean municipally property traveled by the general public
- g) "Patriotic" shall mean used for the purpose of Canada's prosperity, freedom or rights;
- h) "Person" shall mean any individual, firm, group, partnership or organization;
- i) "Solicit" shall mean to make appeals or requests for money from the public;
- j) "Tag Day" shall mean the day or days upon which solicitation is to take place.

3. General

3.1 No person shall solicit money from persons on the highways, sidewalks and / or municipally owned properties within the Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes on any day unless that person is so authorized by the Council or Clerk of the City. This shall include persons in charitable or patriotic work.

3.2 Applications to solicit money from persons on the highways sidewalks and / or municipally owned properties within the City of Kawartha Lakes must be received by the Clerk not less than one week prior to the proposed date of the tag day and shall include all dates requested for tag day, the organization or persons sponsoring the tag day, a contact person, address and telephone number to verify all necessary information and communicate confirmation.

4. Contravention

- 4.1 Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, is liable to a fine or penalty as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33.

5. Repeal of Previous By-laws

- 5.1 All by-laws passed pursuant to Sections 236(14) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45, as amended, authorizing or regulating the fixing of days for solicitation of monetary contributions by persons or organizations in charitable or patriotic work of the Municipal Corporations of the former County of Victoria, namely: The Corporation of the County of Victoria, The Corporation of the Town of Lindsay, The Corporation of the Municipality of Bobcaygeon\Verulam, The Corporation of the Village of Fenelon Falls, The Corporation of the Village of Omemee, The Corporation of the Village of Sturgeon Point, The Corporation of the Village of Woodville, The Corporation of the Township of Bexley, The Corporation of the Township of Carden/Dalton, The Corporation of the Township of Eldon, The Corporation of the Township of Emily, The Corporation of the Township of Fenelon, The Corporation of the Townships of Laxton, Digby & Longford, The Corporation of the Townships of Manvers, The Corporation of the Township of Mariposa, The Corporation of the Township of Ops, The Corporation of the Township of Somerville and the Police Villages of Kirkfield and Pleasant Point,, are hereby repealed.

6. Force and Effect

- 6.1 This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the final day of passing.
