To: The Council of the City of Kawartha Lakes,

Please accept our petition regarding A By-law to Regulate the Discharge of Firearms By-Law 2005 – 329.

Section 3.00 of the by-law, Specific Provisions 3.01 states: "No person other than an officer or police officer who is carrying out their duties, shall discharge a firearm or bow in the designated areas as set out in this Section." The by-law then describes the areas that Section 3.0 applies to.

This petition has 69 signatories. In the interest of public safety, the signatories are asking Council to amend By-law 2005 – 329 and add all of the waterfront properties of Crego Lake to Section 3.00 Specific Provisions, section 3.01 Area Description, as additional properties Listed under the Geographic Township of Somerville.

Background:

There are sixty (60) waterfront properties at Crego Lake. The property owners at Crego Lake formed a not-for-profit corporation named The Kinmount Park Estates Association in 1970. Our association owns and manages 600 acres of undeveloped forest and wetlands around Crego Lake. These lands are a Managed Forest and are protected from development. There is no hunting allowed on our land and we maintain walking trails for our residents. Please find attached excerpts from our By-laws showing we are incorporated (page 1), and outlining the duties and powers of the Association (pages 4 & 5) regarding the environment of Crego Lake and the surrounding lands. We also work closely with Kawartha Conservation and monitor the health of Crego Lake.

KINMOUNT PARK ESTATES ASSOCIATION

BY-LAW NO. 1

BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of Kinmount Park Estates Association (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") as follows:

ARTICLE I

HEAD OFFICE

The Head Office of the Corporation shall be in the Township of Somerville, in the City of Kawartha Lakes (formerly the County of Victoria), and at such place therein as the directors may from time to time determine.

ARTICLE II

SEAL

The corporate seal of the association shall be in the form impressed hereon.

ARTICLE III

REGISTER

The association shall keep a register (hereinafter called "the register") respecting the property which shall note the name and address of the owner of each lake front lot as shown on Plan 494, in the Township of Somerville, in the County of Victoria, who have notified the corporation of their respective interests in the property. The address of each owner shall be the address shown for him on his deed registered in the Registry Office unless the association is given notice of a different address by such owner.

ARTICLE IV

MEETING OF MEMBERS

1. ANNUAL MEETING:

The annual meeting of the members shall be held at such place at such time and on such day in each year as the board may from time to time determine, for the purpose of hearing and receiving the reports and statements required by the by-laws of the association, to be read at and laid before the members at an annual meeting; electing directors; appointing the auditor and fixing or authorizing the board to fix his remuneration and for the transaction of such other business as may properly be brought before the meeting.

11. VOTES TO GOVERN:

At all meetings of members every question shall, unless otherwise required by the by-laws be decided by a majority of the votes as defined in paragraph 7 of this Article IV, duly cast on the question.

12. METHOD OF VOTING:

At any general or special meeting a resolution by the vote of the meeting shall be decided in a show of hands unless a poll is so demanded. A declaration by the Chairman that a resolution has in the show of hands been carried is prima facie proof of the fact without proof of the number or proportion of votes recorded in favour of or against such resolution, but a demand for a poll may be withdrawn.

ARTICLE V

THE ASSOCIATION

1. DUTIES OF THE ASSOCIATION:

The duties of the association shall include, but shall not be limited to the following:

- (a) The regulation and control of the environment and use of the waters of Crego Lake;
- (b) The regulation of the use and enjoyment in common with all members, of the community lands and facilities of Kinmount Park Estates;
- (c) The operation, care, upkeep and maintenance of the roads, docks, fences, gates and other common facilities and services of Kinmount Park Estates;
- (d) Collection of the common element charges from the owners;
- (e) Obtaining and maintaining insurance for the property as may be required by the by-laws;
- (f) Causing audits to be made after every year's end and making auditors' statements available to the owners;
- (g) To promote the study, practice and knowledge of conservation and ecology as it relates to the wildlife and natural surroundings of Kinmount Park Estates.
- (h) To promote the study, practice and knowledge of the prevention of pollution as it relates to Crego Lake and the natural surroundings of Kinmount Park Estates.

2. POWERS OF THE ASSOCIATION:

The powers of the association shall include but shall not be limited to the following:

- (a) Employment and dismissal of personnel necessary for the maintenance and operation of the common elements;

- (b) Adoption and amendment of rules and regulations concerning the operation and use of the community property and its attendant facilities;
- (c) Entering into contracts with conservation or scientific agencies or specialists for the advancement of conservation objectives;
- (d) Employing a manager at a compensation to be determined by the board, to perform such duties and services as the board shall authorize, including but not limited to the foregoing duties;
- (e) Administration of the restrictions originally imposed on Plan 494 by the developer, Simon-Henry Limited, with full powers to amend, vary, modify, substitute or cancel.

ARTICLE VI

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1. The affairs of the association shall be managed by the Board.
2. **QUORUM:**
Until changed by a by-law, the number of directors shall be a minimum of seven (7) and a maximum of nine (9). For Boards with seven (7) or eight (8) Directors, four (4) directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the board. For Boards with nine (9) directors, five (5) directors shall constitute a quorum. Notwithstanding vacancies, the remaining directors may exercise all the powers of the board so long as a quorum of the board remains in office.
3. **QUALIFICATIONS:**
Each director shall be eighteen (18) or more years of age and need not be a member of the association.
4. **ELECTION AND TERM:**
The directors of the association shall be elected in rotation and upon the expiration of their respective term of office, shall retire, but shall be eligible for re-election. At each annual meeting the number of directors required to maintain a Board of seven (7) to nine (9) directors shall be elected for a term of three (3) years.
5. **REMOVAL OF DIRECTORS AND FILLING OF VACANCIES:**
The members may by resolution passed by majority vote at a meeting of members called for such purpose remove any director before the expiration of his term of office. The members may elect a person in place of any director who has been removed, died or resigned for the remainder of his term, at any annual or special meeting.
