# A By-law to Amend By-law 2017-039, being A By-Law to Regulate Animals in the City of Kawartha Lakes

#### Recitals

- 1. By-law 2017-039, being a by-law to regulate animals in the City of Kawartha Lakes, was adopted by Council on February 21, 2017.
- 2. At the August 14, 2018 Regular Council Meeting, Council approved Resolution CR2018-512 directing that the necessary by-law amendments identified in Council Report LIC2018-005, Short Term Residential Rentals Follow-up Report, be brought forward to Council for adoption.
- 3. This by-law amends By-law 2017-039 to reflect this decision and to make a minor administrative correction to a cross-reference within the by-law.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2018-\_\_.

### Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

#### 1.01 **Definitions**:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2017-039 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

#### 1.02 Interpretation Rules:

(a) The words "include" and "including" are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

#### Section 2.00: Amendment Details

- 2.01 **Amendment:** Section 6.06 is added to By-law 2017-039 as follows:
  - **6.06 Administrative Fee:** Where a Person or Owner has received an occurrence inspection an Administrative Fee may be charged for the inspection and the Administrative Fee as set out in the Consolidated Fees By-Law, if not paid, the fee shall be added to the tax roll of the property and shall be collected in a like manner as municipal taxes
- 2.02 **Amendment:** Section 8.05 is amended by removing the reference to 'Section 8.03' and replacing it with 'Section 8.04'.
