By-Law 2018-

A By-law to Amend By-law 2014-026, being A By-law to Require the Owners of Yards within Kawartha Lakes to Clean and Clear Them

Recitals

1. By-law 2014-026, being a By-law to require the owners of yards within Kawartha Lakes to clean and clear them, was adopted by Council on January 14, 2014.
2. At the August 14, 2018 Regular Council Meeting, Council approved Resolution CR2018-512 directing that the necessary by-law amendments identified in Council Report LIC2018-005, Short Term Residential Rentals Follow-up Report, be brought forward to Council for adoption.
3. This by-law amends By-law 2014-026 to reflect this decision.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2018- .

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2014-026, as amended, of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

- 2.01 **Amendment:** Sections 3.05, 4.06 and 6.02 to By-law 2014-026 each be amended by removing the words “Schedule A-9 to”.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement is responsible for the administration of this by-law.

3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
