

The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

By-Law 2018-

A By-law to Repeal By-law 2001-053, being A By-law to Fix Days for Solicitation of Monetary Contributions by Person or Organizations in Charitable or Patriotic Work

Recitals

1. Council adopted By-law 2001-053 on April 23, 2001 to fix days for solicitation of monetary contributions by persons and organizations in charitable or patriotic work.
2. Council adopted Resolution CR2018-XXX on September 25, 2018 directing that a by-law be brought forward to repeal By-law 2001-053 to eliminate the administration of the 'Tag Day' process.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2018- .

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 Definitions: In this by-law,

“City”, “City of Kawartha Lakes” or “Kawartha Lakes” means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

“Council” or “City Council” means the municipal council for the City.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

(a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Repeals

2.01 Repeal: By-law 2001-053 is repealed.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 Administration of this By-law: The City Clerk is responsible for the administration of this By-law.

3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
