That the estimated balance of \$68,412.94 not distributed through the 2019 allocation be made available for funding disbursement in a future year.

Background:

The Bobcaygeon Legacy C.H.E.S.T. Fund Grant Committee met to review and recommend applications for the disbursement of 2019 funding.

All applications were received at the Bobcaygeon Service Centre prior to the posted deadline. Applications were reviewed for completeness based on the application checklist.

Each Committee Member was provided a copy of each application along with the application checklist for the use in preparation for the application review meeting held on November 1, 2018.

The recommendations drawn from the minutes of the meeting form the basis for the findings of this report.

Rationale:

Total interest earned up to September 2018 has been estimated at \$77,888.57. The committee remains committed to the retention of earnings for inflationary growth of the fund. For this purpose (10%) \$7,788.86 of interest earned in 2018 will be allocated directly to the principle of the fund. There is a balance of \$155,438.94 of unallocated funds from previous years, as a result total funding available for the 2019 distribution was established at \$225,538,65 (interest plus balance)

There were 14 applications submitted, with a total request of \$152,583.93. All applications have been reviewed by the committee, and as a result two (2) applications are recommended to receive full funding, ten (10) applications are to receive partial funding, and two (2) applications are to receive no funding due to not meeting application criteria for a total allocation of \$87,026.00.
