# **Background:**

Members of Council are required to sit on various boards and committees throughout the term of Council. This report addresses that requirement by appointing members of Council to boards and committees.

### Rationale:

The Mayor reviewed the preference sheets submitted by each member of Council. This report is provided to Council to seek approval of the appointments of members of Council to various boards and committees.

Attached as Appendix A is a Council Appointment Recommendation letter submitted by the Lindsay Business Improvement Area.

No recommendations for appointment to the Trent Conservation Coalition Source Protection Committee is being made at this time. The City will await a request from them for representation, with guidance of appointee expectations.

A request was made by the Fenelon Falls Cemetery Board for additional time to review the recommendation to dissolve this Board and consolidate it with the Kawartha Lakes Cemetery Board. Should Council support this recommendation, then Councillor Elmslie should be appointed to the Fenelon Falls Cemetery Board for a one-year term to support that review. That Board has committed to a report back to Council within Q1 2019.

Staff will be bringing forward separately an update to Council of established Volunteer Recreation Management Committees. No Council member appointments are required for these committees, but their terms of reference will identify the Mayor and Ward Councillor as liaisons to those respective committees.

There is only one current active task force to be established by Council (Development Charges Task Force). Staff will provide a report to Council with appointment recommendations for Council and public members in Q1 2019.

#### Other Alternatives Considered:

There were no alternatives considered as Council is required to appoint members to boards and committees.

## **Financial/Operation Impacts:**

There are no financial considerations associated with this report as the current remuneration for Council members include attendance at meetings of various boards and committees.
