

# **The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes**

## **By-Law 2019-**

### **A By-law to Amend By-law 2013-043, Being A By-Law to Regulate the Fortification of Land and to Prohibit Excessive Fortification of Land and to Prohibit the Application of Excessive Protective Elements to Land Within the City of Kawartha Lakes (Amendment No. 1)**

#### **Recitals**

1. By-law 2013-043 was passed by Council on March 5, 2013 to regulate the fortification of land, prohibit excessive fortification of land and to prohibit the application of excessive protective elements to land within the City of Kawartha Lakes.
2. Council resolution CR2018-654 approved a Terms of Reference for the Municipal Law Enforcement By-law Appeals Committee on December 11, 2018. The committee mission is to conduct hearings and render decisions for appeals or exemption requests relating to identified Municipal Law Enforcement By-laws including By-law 2013-043, as amended.
3. An amendment is required to align By-law 2013-043 with the Council approved Terms of Reference for the Municipal Law Enforcement By-law Appeals Committee.

**Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2019-      .**

#### **Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation**

##### **1.01 Definitions:**

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2013-043 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

##### **1.02 Interpretation Rules:**

- (a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

#### **Section 2.00: Amendment Details**

- 2.01 **Amendment:** Section 7.02 of By-law 2013-043 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

7.02 **Duties of the Appeal Committee:** The Appeal Committee is delegated Council's decision making authority, as it applies to the refusal to grant a complete or partial exemption, to conduct a hearing relating to the refusal, and shall be governed by the City's Procedural By-law and

the Municipal Law Enforcement By-law Appeals Committee Terms of Reference, as amended from time to time by Council.

### **Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date**

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.

By-law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed, this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2019.
