By-Law 2019-

A By-law to Amend By-law 2017-120, being A By-law to Appoint Four Deputy City Treasurers and to Create and Prescribe the Duties and Responsibilities of that Position

Recitals

1. By-law 2017-120 was passed on June 6, 2017 to appoint four Deputy City Treasurers and to create and prescribe the duties and responsibilities of that position.
2. Deputy City Treasurers were appointed by position and an amendment is required to update staff positions to reflect current titles.
3. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2019- .

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2017-120 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

- 2.01 **Amendment:** Section 4.01 to By-law 2017-120 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- 4.01 **Deputy City Treasurer:** The **Director of Corporate Services**, the **Supervisor, Purchasing**, the **Supervisor, Cost Accounting**, and the **Supervisor, Treasury** are appointed as a Deputy City Treasurer.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The City Treasurer is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
