#### Recitals

- By-law 2017-120 was passed on June 6, 2017 to appoint four Deputy City Treasurers and to create and prescribe the duties and responsibilities of that position.
- 2. Deputy City Treasurers were appointed by position and an amendment is required to update staff positions to reflect current titles.

- 2.01 **Amendment:** Section 4.01 to By-law 2017-120 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
  - **4.01** Deputy City Treasurer: The Director of Corporate Services, the Supervisor, Purchasing, the Supervisor, Cost Accounting, and the Supervisor, Treasury are appointed as a Deputy City Treasurer.
