

The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

By-Law 2019-

A By-law to Amend By-law 2018-039, being a By-law to Regulate Water and Wastewater Services in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

1. The *Municipal Act, 2001*, Section 391 allows for the setting of fees and charges related to the supply of water and sewer services to the public.
2. Council approved the 2019 water and sewer rates with the adoption of the 2019 Operating Budget.
3. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law, 2018-039.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2019- .

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2018-039 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The Schedules attached to this by-law form part of the by-law, and are enforceable as such.
- (b) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

- 2.01 **Amendment:** Schedule A to By-law 2018-039 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Schedule A attached to this by-law.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Director of Public Works, Director of Engineering and Corporate Assets and Treasurer is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 The Treasurer’s authority in relation to this By-law is delegated to the Manager of Revenue and Taxation.

3.03 The Director of Public Works' authority in relation to this By-law is delegated to the Manager of Environmental Services and/or the Supervisor of Water and Wastewater Operations.

3.04 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
