Recitals

- Council adopted Resolution CR2019-298 on April 23, 2019 directing an amendment to By-law 2007-107, being a By-law to Regulate and Govern Trail Uses Along the Victoria Rail Trail Corridor in the City of Kawartha Lakes.
- An amendment is required to permit the use of ROVs along a portion of the Victoria Rail Trail Corridor.
- 3. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2019-__.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

2.01 Amendment: Section 3 of By-law 2007-107 is amended as follows:

Section 3.03 is added as follows:

No person shall operate an ROV on the following sections of the VRTC:

South of Northline Road

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Director of Community Services is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 Effective Date: This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
