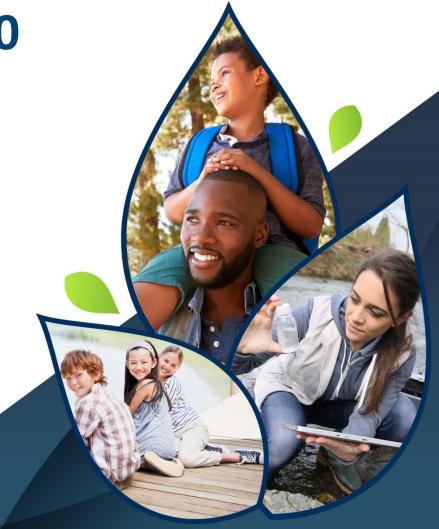

**Our Shared Geography and Partnership** 

- 68 years conserving and restoring the Lake Simcoe watershed
- Watershed is 3400 sq. km and spans 20 municipalities
- Jurisdiction covers all but the City of Orillia
- 18 Board members appointed in 4-year cycle by 9 member municipalities
- One of the fastest growing areas in Ontario

# **2019 Accomplishments**

- Updated current Emergency Mapping Services (EMS)
   mapping, leading to opportunities to reduce flooding in
   the watershed
- 2. Enhanced tracking of environmental trends & restoration efforts through KPI website
- 3. Targeting winter salt management improvement through multi-stakeholder Freshwater discussion paper
- Completed East Holland Tributary Fish Barrier removal project (Aurora)

# **2019 Accomplishments**

- Leveraged FCM funding to complete Building Condition assessments (November) and a Preliminary Financial Strategy to update LSRCA's asset management plan (December).
- Developed watershed-scale Climate Change Adaptation strategy
- 7. Substantially completed Scanlon Creek Operation Centre renovation (office space, workspace and storage)

## Challenges: Bill 108

MECP is defining the Provincially mandated programs and services for Conservation Authorities.

#### **Budget Implications:**

- 1) Transition period has yet to be defined
- 2) Funding approval logistics and implications
- 3) Seeking increased transparency as Provincial funding was reduced by 49% (\$65K for 2019)

# **Partnering Together on Projects**

- 1. Flood Relief program through Emergency Management System (EMS) mapping
- 2. Working with municipalities to address urban stormwater ponds (design and maintenance)
- 3. Natural Heritage forestry work at the Cawthra Mulock Nature Reserve (14,000 trees/shrubs)
- 4. Leveraging municipal expertise to advance work in asset management, diversity and inclusion and records management

# **Engaging our Municipal Partners**

- Developed Budget Companion Report, highlighting LSRCA's outcomes and expenditures by service area
- 2. CAO provides semi annual update presentations to Council at all 9 funding municipalities
- 3. CAO hosts annual municipal CAO roundtable
- 4. Piloted new Finance roundtable/update meeting

#### **2020 Focus for LSRCA**

- 1. Completing the final activities in 2016-2020 Strategic Plan (4 Goals/9 Outcomes/42 Activities)
- Finishing the Operation Review of the Authority's Programs and Services
- 3. Working together to address the financial pressures on our municipal funding partners:
  - a) Status Quo budget: No new FTE's
  - b) Deferred Strategic Initiatives 1% funding
  - c) Trying to accommodate revised funding targets

### Respecting the Taxpayer

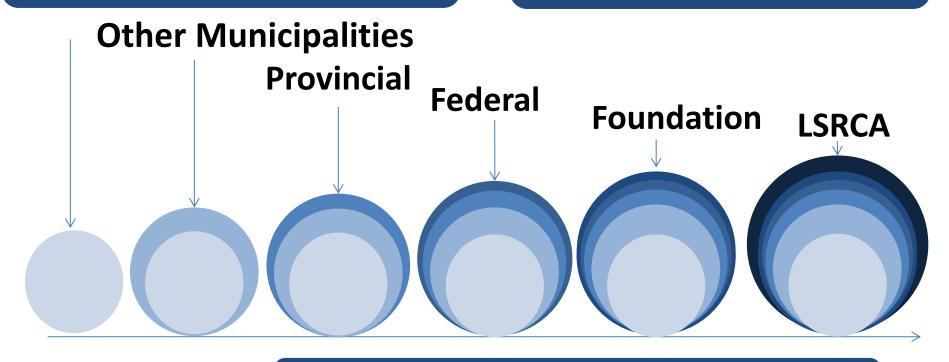
- New for 2020: Engagement Strategy (reserve funded); final activity of 2016-2020 Strategic Plan
- Found reductions to offset the \$65K loss of MNRF funding
- Reasonable economic adjustments for existing staff
- 1-2% added to cost for inflation if applicable
