

# **The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes**

## **By-Law 2019-**

### **A By-law to Repeal By-law 2017-192, being A By-law to Appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Kawartha Lakes**

#### **Recitals**

1. Council adopted By-law 2017-192 on September 26, 2017 to appoint Christopher Tassone as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the City of Kawartha Lakes.
2. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-law 2017-192 due to changes in staffing.

**Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2019-      .**

#### **Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation**

##### **1.01 Definitions:** In this by-law,

**“City”, “City of Kawartha Lakes” or “Kawartha Lakes”** means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

**“Council” or “City Council”** means the municipal council for the City.

##### **1.02 Interpretation Rules:**

- (a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

#### **Section 2.00: Repeals**

- 2.01 **Repeal:** By-law 2017-192 is repealed.

#### **Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date**

- 3.01 **Administration of this By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing is responsible for the administration of this By-law.

3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.

By-law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed, this 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2019.
