Re: Notice of Requirement for Council Resolution related to proposed Amendments to the Trent Source Protection Plan and Assessment Report as per Section 34 of the *Clean Water Act*

Dear Ms. Ritchie,

The City of Kawartha Lakes recently received correspondence from the Trent Conservation Coalition dated December 13, 2019, inviting your municipality to provide feedback on the Summary of Proposed Amendments to the Trent Source Protection Plan and Assessment Report as a result of recent upgrades to the Canadiana Shores Municipal Drinking Water System.

The upgrades to the Canadiana Shores Municipal Drinking Water System are limited to a new well configuration and have resulted in slight changes to the delineation of Wellhead Protection Area A. No changes are proposed to the policies in the Source Protection Plan.

This letter is to provide notice, as per Section 34(3) of the *Clean Water Act, 2006*, that a council resolution will be required from the City of Kawartha Lakes to endorse the proposed amendments to the Trent Source Protection Plan and Assessment Report. This resolution is required prior to the initiation of a prescribed 35-day public consultation period planned to commence in February 2020.
