A By-law to Amend By-law 2019-031, being A By-law to Authorize the Civil Marriage Solemnization Service in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

1. By-law 2019-031, being a By-law to authorize the Civil Marriage Solemnization Service in the City of Kawartha Lakes, was adopted by Council on February 19, 2019.
2. Due to staff changes it is necessary to update the delegated authority within By-law 2019-031.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-Law 2020-.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2014-026, as amended, of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The word “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

2.01 Amendment: Section 2.03 shall be amended to read as follows:

The City Clerk is authorized to delegate Joel Watts, Deputy Clerk, and Sarah O’Connell, Deputy Clerk, to solemnize marriages.

Section 3:00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The City Clerk is responsible for the administration of this by-law.

3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force the 18th day of February, 2020.

By-Law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed, this 18th day of February, 2020.
