



Statement of Partnership Agreement

Lead Members & Partners/Affiliates

Purpose

Articulates the shared sense of purpose and clearly identifies partnership expectations.

Rationale

Outlines why the partnership is in place, how partners will behave when working together, and how decisions will be made.

Action

It is expected that all participants, regardless of level of commitment sign this commitment.

Signature Required by June 30

Interim Ontario Health Team Agreement

Lead Members

Purpose

Supports organizations in working towards establishing an Ontario Health Team.

Rationale

Provides structure to the relationship between partners, contains key terms including: confidentiality, independent governance, joint public communications, and cost sharing.

Action

It is expected that Lead Members sign this nonbinding commitment.

Signature Required by June 30

Data Sharing Agreement

Lead Members & Partners/Affiliates

Purpose

Enables more effective and efficient patient information sharing that will translate into better patient care.

Rationale

Outlines the legal obligations and responsibilities amongst participants to electronically access personal health information which is in the custody or under the control of another participant to improve the delivery of healthcare to their mutual patients/clients.

Action

It is expected that all Lead Members sign this commitment.
