- Lindsay Transit is a highly utilized service. Established in 1977
- Consists of three separate routes (Green Route, Red Route and Blue Route)
- LIMO Specialized Transit

Background

- Transit Master Plan is designed to take the City Transit to the next level
- Many groups, organizations and individuals have had input into the Transit Master Plan, over 1100 people
- Recommend fourth route in 2021

Orange Route

- More buses on the Blue route, 30 minute service
- Orange Bus to service downtown, shopping centers and Fleming College
- Other routes provide greater Lindsay coverage
- Capital costs covered by ICIP granting
- Annual operating cost \$108,106.00
