

The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

By-Law 2017-

A By-law to Amend By-law 2014-181, being a By-law to Authorize the Undertaking of Work on Private Residential Property and Providing a Financing Program for the Lakeview Water Co-op Drinking Water System as Local Improvements in the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

1. An amendment is required to change the positions outlined in the by-law and to assign responsibility for the implementation of the by-law.
2. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2017- .

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2014-181 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

- 2.01 **Amendment to Definitions:** Section 1.01 is amended by adding:

“**Director of Corporate Services**” means the person who holds that position and his or her delegate(s) or, in the event of organizational changes, another person designated by Council.

- 2.02 **Amendment to Definitions:** Section 1.01 is amended by adding:

“**Revenue and Procurement Manager**” means the person who holds that position and his or her delegate(s) or, in the event of organizational changes, another person designated by Council.

- 2.03 **Amendment to Definitions:** Section 1.01 is amended by deleting:

“**Corporate Services Manager, Revenue and Taxation/Deputy Treasurer**” means the person who holds that position and his or her delegate(s) or, in the event of organizational changes, another person designated by Council.

- 2.04 **Amendment to Section 3.01:** Section 3.01 to By-law 2016-131 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Director of Corporate Services and the Revenue and Procurement Manager are responsible for the administration of this by-law.

- 2.05 **Amendment to Appendix A – Step 4:** Step 4 be amended to delete the reference to Corporate Services Manager, Revenue and Taxation/Deputy Treasurer certification and insert Director of Corporate Services and/or the Revenue and Procurement Manager’s certification.

- 2.06 **Amendment to Appendix B – Definitions:** Definitions within Appendix B be amended to delete the definition of Corporate Services Manager, Revenue and Taxation/Deputy Treasurer and insert a definition of Director of Corporate Services and Revenue and Procurement Manager as noted in Sections 2.02 and 2.03 of this By-law.

2.05 **Amendment to Appendix B – Signature Line:** The Signature Line is to be amended to delete the reference to Corporate Services Manager, Revenue and Taxation/Deputy Treasurer and insert Revenue and Procurement Manager certification and to remove specific name references.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Director of Corporate Services is responsible for the administration of this by-law.

3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
