A By-law to Amend By-law 2016-144, being a By-law for Collection and Management of Waste and Recyclables within the City of Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

- 1. By-law 2016-144, being a By-law for Collection and Management of Waste and Recyclables within the City of Kawartha Lakes was passed on August 9, 2016.
- 2. For enforcement purposes, the language in the by-law requires revision in order for the by-law provisions to constitute an offence.
- 3. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law.

2.01 **Amendment:** Section 3.04 b) to By-law 2016-144 is amended by removing:

and replacing it with:

Every user or owner who sets out waste for curbside collection shall ensure the waste meets the following requirements:

2.02 Amendment: Section 3.05 b) to By-law 2016-144 is amended by removing:

Recyclable materials set out shall meet the following requirements;

and replacing it with:

Every user or owner who sets out recyclable materials for curbside collection shall ensure the recyclable materials meet the following requirements;

2.03 <u>Amendment:</u> Section 4.08 a) to By-law 2016-144 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

No user or owner shall deposit any Hazardous or liquid industrial waste as per O. Reg. 347 at any landfill site;

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

- 3.01 <u>Administration of the By-law:</u> The Director of Public Works is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
