## **Background:**

As provided in Section 2.06 of this By-Law, staff annually update the Consolidated Fees Bylaw using consumer price index (CPI) estimates provided by Statistics Canada for Ontario.

## Rationale:

The analysis of the 2021 data indicates that the Ontario CPI was trending upwards from 2020, resulting in an increase of 4%.
