A By-law to Authorize the Sale of City Owned Property Identified as Lot 4, 5, and 6 on Plan 9, in the Geographic Township of Manvers, in the City of Kawartha Lakes, PIN 63260-0189

Recitals

- The subject property was declared to be surplus to municipal needs and its sale was approved by City Council on the 24th day of September 2013 by the adoption of Report LM2013-009 by CR2013-848
- 2. Notice of intention of City Council to pass this By-Law was given by notice duly published in the City of Kawartha Lakes This Week newspaper in the City of Kawartha Lakes on the 1st, 8th and 15th days of October, 2020 and in the Peterborough This Week on the 2nd, 9th and 16th days of October, 2020 in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act and By-Law 2010-118, as amended
- 3. The proposed By-Law came before Council for consideration at its regular Council meeting on the 16th day of November, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. and at that time no person objected to then proposed by-law nor claimed that this land would be prejudicially affected
- The sale of this land was approved by Council on the 24th day of September 24, 2021 by the adoption of Report LM2013-009 by CR2013-848

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2021-__.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions**: In this by-law,

"City", "City of Kawartha Lakes" or "Kawartha Lakes" means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

"City Clerk" means the person appointed by Council to carry out the duties of the clerk described in section 228 of the Municipal Act, 2001;

"Council" or "City Council" means the municipal council for the City;

"Mayor" means the Chief Executive Officer of the City.

- 1.02 **Interpretation Rules:** The words "include" and "including" are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.
- 1.03 **Statutes:** References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.

1.04 **Severability:** If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.

Section 2.00: Effective Date

2.01 **Sale:** The property legally described as Lots 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 9, in the Geographic Township of Manvers, in the City of Kawartha Lakes, is hereby authorized the be sold to Darolyn Jones for One Hundred, Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$175,000.00), plus HST, if applicable, plus the cost of the reference plan, advertising, registrations, City staff time expenses, legal fees and disbursements and any other costs incurred by the City in connection to this transaction.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
