A By-law to Repeal By-Law 2021-171, being a By-Law to Appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited By-law Enforcement Purposes

Recitals

1. Council deems it appropriate to repeal By-Law 2021-171, appointing an Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for Limited By-Law Enforcement Purposes for the City of Kawartha Lakes due to changes in staffing.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2021-____.

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 **Definitions:** In this by-law,

“**City**”, “**City of Kawartha Lakes**” or “**Kawartha Lakes**” means The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes and includes its entire geographic area;

“**Council**” or “**City Council**” means the municipal council for the City;

1.02 **Interpretation Rules:**

- (a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.
