# **Background:**

The following is an update on the Heritage Planning program for January 2022.

**January 25 Council Meeting:** Council passed an amendment to the Heritage Delegated Authority By-law (By-law 2019-154) to delegate authority to negotiate extensions to timelines under the Ontario Heritage Act and to execute and amend heritage easement agreements. The amendment to the designation by-law 1201 Salem Road was also passed at this meeting.

**February 8 Committee of the Whole:** The Committee of the Whole will receive the Heritage Inventory Framework and the objection to the listing of 1824 County Road 46, Eldon Township at their meeting of February 8. These two items were reviewed by the Committee in January. Staff will be making a presentation on the inventory project.

**Archaeological Management Plan:** Staff are beginning on the preparation of an archaeological management plan for the City. This is a multi-year project that will produce a plan and associated policies to guide the management of archaeological resources in the municipality. Initial planning and consultation has started on this project and the Committee will be kept informed on its progress.

**Trent Student Project:** Two Trent students are working on a research project for the City looking at the heritage structures and historic landscape at Sturgeon Point. They are completing this research as part of their Community-Based Resource Management course and will be invited to present their findings to the Committee when their research is complete.
