

# **The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes**

## **By-Law 2022-XXX**

### **A By-law to Amend By-law 2020-001, being the Procedural By-law of the City of Kawartha Lakes**

#### **Recitals**

1. The Municipal Elections Act, 1996 s.6(1) has been amended for the term of Council to commence November 15<sup>th</sup> following each municipal election.
2. No business shall proceed until after the declarations of office are taken by the incoming Council forming a quorum.
3. Council adopted Resolution \_\_\_\_\_ on \_\_\_\_\_, 2022 directing that Staff prepare an amendment to By-law 2020-001, being the Procedural By-law for the City of Kawartha Lakes, to provide for the Inaugural Meeting date to be adjusted (3.02).
4. This change requires an amendment to the consolidated by-law replacing section 3.02 in its entirety.

**Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2022-XXX.**

#### **Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation**

##### **1.01 Definitions:**

All defined terms in this amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2020-001 of the City of Kawartha Lakes, and acknowledge the newly amended definition in Section 2.01 of this amending by-law.

##### **1.02 Interpretation Rules:**

(a) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

#### **Section 2.00: Amendment Details**

- 2.02 The Inaugural Meeting shall be held on the first day of the new term of Council provided that it falls on a business day, otherwise it will be held the first business day following the day that the new term commences. The Inaugural Meeting shall take place in the Council Chambers, Main Administration Building, 26 Francis Street, Lindsay.

### **Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date**

- 3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The City Clerk is responsible for the administration of this by-law.
- 3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
