



The Piccadilly Theatre was built at the corner of Shaftesbury St. and Bond St. in 1947 with this iconic neon marquee sign installed in 1951.

The marquee sign became a beacon for residents and tourists alike. After many years of the theatre providing entertainment, which included movies and various events, the building fell into disrepair and was demolished in 2016. However, a group of dedicated Piccadilly residents and businesses were able to salvage the marquee sign. With the generous support and contributions of various artspeople and benefactors, locally and beyond, the Piccadilly Theatre marquee was fully restored and installed on this site in September 2018.
