Background:

The following is an update on the Heritage Planning program for February 2022.

February 22 Council Meeting: Council approved the adoption of the Heritage Inventory Framework presented by staff at the February 8 Committee of the Whole meeting. Council also reviewed the request by the owner of 1824 County Road 46 to remove the property from the Heritage Register and decided to remove the property from the Register.

March 8 Committee of the Whole: There are three heritage-related reports being presented to Committee of the Whole at its March 8 meeting. These are: the proposed designation of 1590 Elm Tree Road; the repeal and replacement of the designating by-law for 50 Victoria Avenue North; and the Municipal Heritage Committee's 2022 work plan.
