Re:	Pleasant Point Park

Recommendation

That the Memo from Councillor Ashmore, **regarding Pleasant Point Park**, be received;

That staff be directed to work with a citizens group in Pleasant Point to convert the present use of their park on Indian Trail to a multi-use park;

That staff report back to council by end of Q3, 2022, with an update on progress of discussions with the citizens group, and further direction needed from council, financial or otherwise, to implement conversion to a multiuse park; and

That these recommendations be brought forward to Council for consideration at the next Regular Council Meeting.

Rationale

Pleasant Point Community Park is located on Indian Trail within the community. Presently, the park has been used as a baseball diamond and field as well as a small area to use for gatherings. Some community members have proposed the idea of a multi purpose park. Some of the proposals would include tennis courts, pickle ball and basketball and a mini off leash dog park to name a few. A recent survey was sent out and close to 95% of the citizens were in favour of such a development.



The local citizens are asking that Council support this initiative and allow time to work with staff for this transition to occur. Many steps will have to be taken such as planning and financing of the transformation.
