The Haliburton, Kawartha, Pine Ridge District Health Unit is launching the “Yellow Ribbon” animal bite awareness Campaign this spring.

This campaign is based on an international movement known as the “Yellow Dog Project” created for dogs that need space. By tying a yellow ribbon or something similar to the dog's leash you are indicating that this dog needs space, for whatever reason.

The campaign aims to increase awareness about the sharp and steady increase in animal bites in our communities and offers a way to identify when dogs need their space.

In the last 3 years, our inspectors investigated over 600 animal bite/scratch incidents annually in Haliburton County, City of Kawartha Lakes and Northumberland County.

We are looking to partner with our Municipalities, local businesses, and veterinarians on this initiative. There is no cost to the municipality for their participation.

We request that you consider the following options to support this initiative:

1. Share the campaign information on your website,
2. Allow promotional static cling stickers provided by the HKPRDHU to be placed in the windows of municipal vehicles including by-law, fire, ambulance and municipal police services etc.
3. Allow promotional static cling stickers to be placed in the windows of entrance doors to municipal buildings, libraries, sport arenas etc..
4. Distribute free promotional items i.e. yellow ribbons with information cards, dog poop bag holders with promotional messaging etc. at the Municipal licensing locations where dog licenses are purchased.
