## **Background:**

Fleet Services has been attempting to procure new Transit Buses by typical means (Tender or Quote) to upgrade the current bus fleet to align with the City's Non-Emergency Fleet Policy. A competitive process was done in 2021. With pandemic and post pandemic supply chain challenges, new bus delivery dates are scheduling into 2024. As a result of the delayed production, inadequate parts availability and long delivery dates on the new bus builds, alternatives were investigated. All bus and vehicle manufacturing no matter the configuration are experiencing long lead times/delays (18-20 months from date of order). Therefore; the purchase of any new bus will not satisfy the City's immediate need for bus fleet. The proposed unit is to replace E19 and was included in the 2022 Capital budget.



### **Rationale:**

With the current market delays on purchasing new, it is in the best interest of the City to replace with used/on lot buses as required to keep the fleet current and operational. A new 2022 unit (no longer available/not manufacturing anymore 2022 units) was priced through a local Ontario distributor/vendor and they provided a cost estimate of \$220,000 for the same unit and configuration. The 2023 bus production order board is in the process of opening for units to be delivered late 2023 early 2024. With the volatility of the market the same local bus distributor would not provide a firm price on a 2023 unit but stated we should expect the exact same unit to cost approximately \$300,000 in 2023. By purchasing this used/on the lot unit, we would enjoy a Cost savings/avoidance of \$54,055 to \$134,055.

### **Other Alternatives Considered:**

No other alternative is being recommended as there are no new buses available until 2024.

# **Alignment to Strategic Priorities**

The purchase of a used/on lot transit bus aligns with the four (4) goals listed below as part of the City's Strategic Priority
