

The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes

By-Law 2022-

A By-law to Amend By-Law 2018-010, Being a By-law to License, Regulate and Govern Taxicab, Limousine and Transportation Network Businesses and Their Owners, Operators and Brokers and Drivers in Kawartha Lakes

Recitals

1. By-Law 2018-010 was adopted by Council on January 30, 2018 to license, regulate and govern taxicab, limousine and transportation network businesses and their owners, operators and brokers and drivers in Kawartha Lakes.
2. At the Regular Council Meeting of July 19, 2022, Council approved an increase in the meter drop rate to better align with current inflation and rising services costs through the adoption of CR2022- .
3. This By-Law amends By-Law 2021-072 to reflect that direction.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kawartha Lakes enacts this By-law 2022- .

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 Definitions:

All defined terms in the amending By-law take their meaning from By-law 2018-010 of the City of Kawartha Lakes.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- (a) The Schedules attached to this by-law form part of the by-law, and are enforceable as such.
- (b) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.

1.03 Statutes: References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time, that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.

1.04 Severability: If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.

Section 2.00: Amendment Details

2.01 **Amendment:** The table within Schedule “B” shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

Taxicab Meter Rate for Out-Of-Town Journeys	\$4.25	\$3.50
Taxicab Waiting Rate	\$.58 per minute (\$35.00/hour)	

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 **Administration of the By-law:** The Manager of Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing is responsible for the administration of this by-law.

3.02 **Effective Date:** This By-Law shall come into force on the date it is finally passed.
