Recitals

- Council adopted Resolution CW2022-157 and CW2022-159 on June 21, 2022 directing amendments to By-law Number 2005-328 the Speed Limit By-law.
- 2. An amendment is required to change speed limits on Highways.
- 3. These changes require an amendment to the original by-law.
