#### **Background:**

At its meeting of January 13, 2022, Building and Property staff presented the Committee with a "thinking piece" concept site plan for the outdoor space at the Lindsay Old Gaol (50 Victoria Avenue North). The intent of this concept was to begin a conversation with the Committee on the potential future use of the space when the courtyard walls were demolished in early 2022. The Committee provided input to Building and Property staff at that time with the understanding that there was not, at that time, budget allocated for the project and the thinking piece was to get the Committee thinking about the future use of the space.

As the courtyard walls have now been demolished, Building and Property staff are developing a plan for the future use and design of the space. Staff will be attending the meeting to discuss the project with the Committee as a key stakeholder and begin to discuss needs, wants and requirements for this space.
